Join Groups in Digital Chalkboard

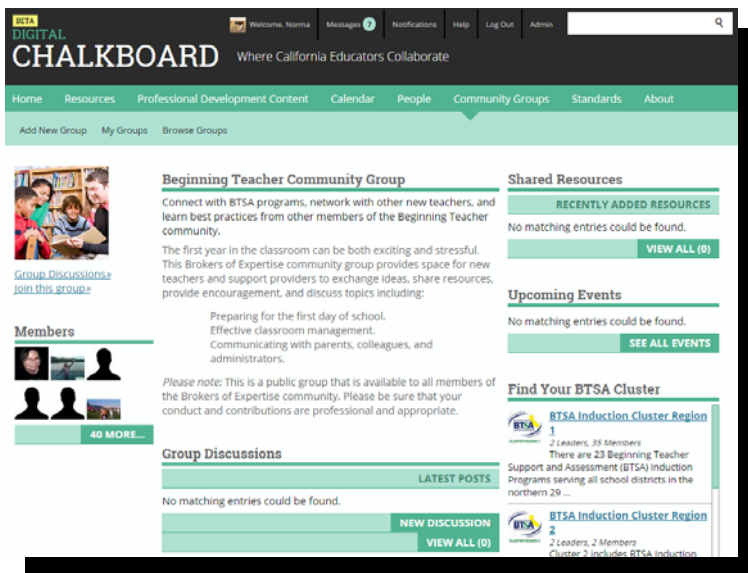
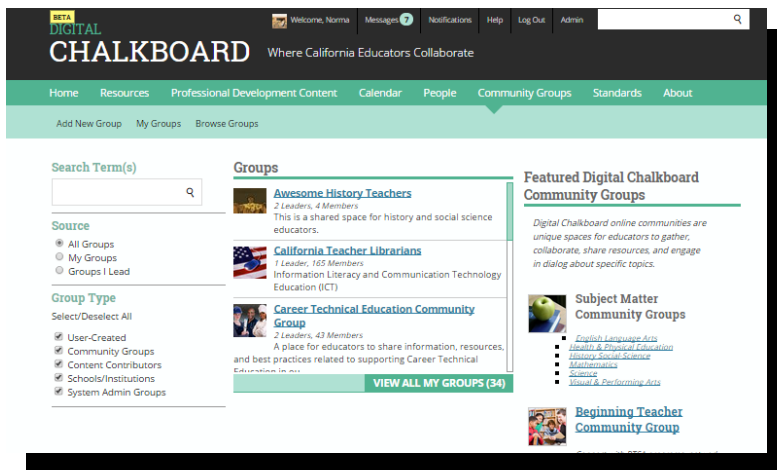
Groups bring educators together, providing a space for members to gather, share resources and engage in dialog around a central topic or organization. You may be a member of many different groups such as:

School/Institution Groups: When you join the Digital Chalkboard community, you are automatically added to the group associated with your school, district or county office. From there, you may join or be invited to join other groups based on your interests.

User-Created Groups: As a member of the Digital Chalkboard community, you can create your own groups and invite people to become members. This is especially useful if you wish to create groups to work on projects, discuss specific topics, or share resources.

Types of Groups

- **Public Groups** allow you to join a group without additional approval.
- **Semi-Private Groups** allow users to send a request to join a group. Once the group leader accept your request, you become part of the group.
- **Private Groups** are restricted to members who receive an invitation to join from a group leader.
