Find Resources

There are a number of different ways to search or browse resources in Digital Chalkboard. Begin by clicking on the **Resources** tab in the main menu.

1 Search by Keyword or Name

Type terms in the search box and click the “search” button to see all related resources.

2 Search by Standards Supported

Many resources can be found by browsing the standards they match. Click “Browse the Standards” to view resources by standard.

3 Search by Subject or Topic

Browse the list of subjects and check the box next to your desired subject(s). After making your selection, click the “search” button to see all resources for the selected subject(s).

Filtering Search Results

If you find that your search returns too many or too few resources, you can use other filters located in the left sidebar to refine your search and find resources of a specific type or that contain specific content.

Once you have selected or deselected the desired options, click the “Refilter” button to search using these applied filters.
