2. Iqbal states that “the lines will never be erased.” How does he know this? Do you think the other children are ignorant to this information, or do they just not want to believe it? Why?
3. Hypothesize if Fatima and Iqbal escape, what would they do, where would they go, and what do you think they would be feeling?
4. Why do you think that even if they share the same fate, the children bully each other?
5. Why do you think the other children were so upset when Iqbal told them that “the debt is never erased”?
6. How do you think Fatima knew Iqbal wasn’t scared the first time she saw him?
